In addition to having the opportunity to share work through the panel, at least one senior scholar will be designated as a reviewer who will have read the paper ahead of time and will be prepared to discuss the paper and offer constructive comments at the session and/or in writing.

The Call for Papers presenters will be responsible for paying their registration fee and hotel and travel expenses.
