The Section on European Law is pleased to announce a Call for Papers for the Section's New Voices in European Law: Works-in-Progress Panel. Up to four emerging scholar faculty members will be selected to present their papers at the AALS 2021 Annual Meeting.

The purpose of this works-in-progress program is to bring together emerging scholars (pre-tenure or teaching for eight or fewer years) and senior European law scholars for a productive exchange on the works presented. Each emerging scholar will be paired with at least one senior scholar who will review the paper presented. The panel offers emerging scholars an opportunity to present and receive useful feedback on papers that have not yet been published. The senior commentator will be prepared to offer constructive comments at the session and/or in writing. Papers must be "in progress" as of the time of the Annual Meeting in January 2021. A paper accepted for publication but still undergoing revision is considered "in progress." Presenters selected for the panel must submit a draft paper of sufficient length (30 - 60 pages double-spaced), along with an abstract, by a to-be-determined date in December 2020, to allow the commentators time to prepare comments.
