

**Call for Proposals: New Challenges in Disability Rights Litigation,
2023 AALS Annual Meeting**

The AALS Section on Disability Law is hosting a program on New Challenges in Disability Rights Litigation at the AALS 2023 Annual Meeting in San Diego, California, January 3-6, 2023.

Throughout the past year, disability law issues have been at the center of news and high-profile litigation. This program aims to discuss several major areas of debate in the courts and the news. Potential topics include (but are not limited to) remote work as a disability accommodation, disparate impact claims under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act and under the ADA, airline travel for individuals with disabilities, and education-related topics such as masking wars and adjusting Individual Education Plans (IEPs) to remote learning. We seek participants to discuss these or other timely disability law topics.

If you are interested in participating, please send a 400-600 word description of what you would like to discuss. We particularly encourage submissions from junior scholars and members of underrepresented groups in legal academia.
