
- Does selling recorded lectures violate faculty rights of publicity?

Commercialization (2)

Right of publicity

 Appropriation of P's name or likeness for D's use or benefit

Likely preempted by Copyright Act

o E.g. *Melendez v. Sirius XM Radio, Inc.*, 50 F.4th 294 (2d Cir. 2022)

Student Privacy in Videos

• FERPA Regs, 34 C.F.R. § 99.30

 Require signed written consent before disclosure of PII from students' "education records"

"Education record"

- o (1) Directly related to a student; and
- (2) Maintained by an educational institution or by a party acting for the institution
- Dept. of Educ. <u>FAQ on Photos and Videos Under</u>
 <u>FERPA</u>: distinction between "direct" and "incidental"



Virtual Class



Class Sharing of Recordings

- "[A]ssuming the video recording does not disclose PII from student education records during a virtual classroom lesson ...,
- "...FERPA would not prohibit the teacher from making a recording of the lesson available to students enrolled in the class."
 - Dept. of Educ., FERPA and Virtual Learning During COVID-19 (Kala Shah Surprenant, Acting Director, Student Privacy Policy Office, March 30, 2020)



Student Data Collection & Use

- Internal disclosures require "legitimate educational interest"
- Vendors
 - Use of education records must be "under the direct control" of the university
 - Must be prohibited from disclosing PII from education records without consent unless pursuant to specified FERPA exceptions



Student Data Collection & Use (2)

- Electronic Communications Privacy Act
 - Prevents disclosure of content of communications

CCPA

 Purpose limitation: Use of personal information limited to purposes for which information was collected or processed

AAUP 1915 Declaration

GENERAL REPORT OF THE COM-MITTEE ON ACADEMIC FREEDOM AND ACADEMIC TENURE

PRESENTED AT THE ANNUAL MEETING OF THE ASSOCIATION

December 31, 1915



External Monitoring

AAUP 1915 Declaration

- o "Discussions in the classroom ought not to be supposed to be utterances for the public at large....
- o "It has, unfortunately, sometimes happened in this country that sensational newspapers have quoted and garbled such remarks."

1985 Joint Statement on AIA

 External monitoring "will have a chilling effect on the academic freedom of both students and faculty members."

GW Law Recording Policy (9/9/22)

- Law School & faculty have exclusive right to record classes
- Sole purpose to allow student review of class discussion
 - o "Any other use ... is strictly prohibited without the prior, express permission of the relevant faculty member."
- Students Impliedly Consent

Recording Policy

- Law School & faculty have exclusive right to record classes
- Sole purpose to allow student review of class discussion
 - o "Any other use ... is strictly prohibited without the prior, express permission of the relevant faculty member."
- Students Impliedly Consent
- Add: Student videos to document internal complaint permitted

Internal Monitoring

AAUP Committee A, 1983

o "[A]n academic community will not subject its members to the debilitating inhibitions and anxieties of covert surveillance."
